If you are self-directed with the ability to work effectively within a team environment, are compassionate, creative and resourceful, please consider this opportunity. This position will include client support and public education for the Program.

#### **Responsibilities include:**

- Providing public education on Human Trafficking across Wellington County.
- Providing options, referrals and connections to clients and community resources as needed.
- Providing internal referrals to clients for ongoing support.
- Assisting the Anti-Human Trafficking Counsellor with supports for county clients in the application for services including health, housing, income, etc.
- Coordinating practical support packages for clients.
- Developing presentations on Human Trafficking in collaboration with the Anti-Human Trafficking Counsellor.
- Developing educational resources in collaboration with Public Educator on Human Trafficking.
- Correlating program statistical reports.

#### **The successful candidate will have:**

- Degree or diploma in a Social Services or related field.
- Minimum 2 years previous experience working with and advocating for sexually trafficked women.
- Crisis intervention, counselling education and experience.
- Experience in working with clients who are or have experienced sexual violence.
- Specialized knowledge of trauma, mental health and substance abuse issues.
- Administration/organizational skills with strong computer competency and attention to detail.
- Advanced familiarity with current community resources.
