Our team is seeking a highly motivated **Summer Student - Public Education & Engagement Intern**. This **eight week 35 hours per week** position, reporting to the Public Educator, requires a self-starting, team player with a strong commitment to social justice and passion for preventing gender-based violence.

#### **Responsibilities Include:**

- Assist with the management of the Agency's online presence including website and social media platforms for Public Education related events or awareness campaigns.
- Assist with the development of educational materials related to gender-based violence prevention including presentations, web-based and physical materials and social media content.
- Increase program and service awareness to the public by ensuring diverse and marginalized communities have full access to information.
- Attend public and online events to promote Guelph-Wellington Women in Crisis.
- Assist with the planning and promotion of social activism events i.e. Take Back the Night.
- Assist with media relations.
- Assist in day to day management of office as needed.
